- P: Lord of heaven and earth, forgive us all our sins. As we see the world in darkness and in need, bring us faith, love and power to bring light and help.
- C: The Lord has made known His salvation; He has remembered His truth and love;

This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they

came together, she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit. Because Joseph her husband was a righteous man and did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly. But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: "The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" -- which means, "God with us."


